JOB SUMMARY: Responsible for delivery of products to customers at various locations in a safe and timely manner

ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS:

1. Inspect truck before and after trips and submit report indicating truck condition
2. Read all paperwork, including bill of lading, to determine assignment. Fill out proper paperwork before leaving facility.
3. Drivers may be required to load or unload, or assist in loading and unloading of truck.
4. Drivers will need to perform pre-trip inspection on equipment and might have to service truck with oil, fuel, and radiator fluid to maintain tractor-trailer.
5. Drive tractor-trailer combination, applying knowledge of commercial driving regulations, to transport and deliver products.
6. Maneuver truck into loading or unloading position.
7. Upon arrival at destination, Driver fills out paperwork for “pre” unloading and then completes the “post” unloading section when completed. Obtains Customer signature.
8. Maintains driver log according to I.C.C. regulations.
9. Use hands and arms in handling, loading, and unloading or positioning transfer hoses and moving other objects during the load/unload process

JOB REQUIREMENTS:

1. Must be clean and neat in appearance, well-groomed hair (no beards when customers request.)
2. Must have a high school diploma or equivalent and be able to read and write the English Language.
3. Minimum 5 years over-the-road experience.
4. Must hold valid commercial operating permit issued by state of residence. May not possess more than one license.
5. Must possess or be willing to get HazMat and tanker endorsements on class A CDL.
6. Must have a “home” telephone number.
7. Must be a citizen of the United States or possess documentation showing legal residence in the U.S.
8. Must pass a D.O.T. physical examination and controlled substance test.
9. Must not be “disqualified” under Section 391.12 of the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Regulations.

Safe driving record during the past thirty-six months, including:

- No serious/major moving violations.

- No more than three minor moving violations.
- No drug- or alcohol-related offenses.
- No major preventable accidents or multiple minor preventable accidents.
- No more than three minor violations or minor accidents combined.

Performing General Physical Activities:

Drivers perform physical activities that require considerable use of arms and legs, and moving your whole body, such as climbing, lifting, balancing, walking, stooping, and handling of materials. Lifting could include objects up to 60 lbs.
